Sir,

For TRAI consumer welfare should be its first priority. However, continuation of IUC will only ensure hefty profits for telecom companies without caring for upgradation of technology, connecting poorest citizens of India etc. Maximization of industry profits cannot be the priority.

To continue with IUC would be patently anti-consumer as burden of this subsidy has to be borne ultimately by the consumers only. TRAI should not establish a regime which taxes the consumers in form of IUC for subsidizing and supporting telecom operators.
