Subject: Direction under Section 13 read with Section 11 (1) (b) (ix) of the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India Act 1997 regarding posting of information pertaining to USO related activities on their web site by the service providers.

WHEREAS Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF) presently provides subsidy support for Public Telecom & Information Services and household telephones in rural and remote areas. Since service providers are contributing to this fund for Universal Service Obligations, it is essential that the fund be disbursed in a transparent manner.

AND WHEREAS as per clause 11 (1) (b) (ix) of TRAI Act 1997, TRAI has to ensure effective compliance of universal service obligations and as per clause 11 (4) of TRAI Act 1997, TRAI has to ensure transparency while exercising its powers and discharging its functions.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to evolve a transparent mechanism for activities supported from USOF viz. Village Public Telephones (VPTs), Rural Community Phones (RCPs), Public Telecom and Information Centers (PTICs)/High Speed Public Telecom and Information Centers (HPTICs), Rural Direct Exchange Lines (RDELs), etc. To ensure that the data / information pertaining to USO related activities submitted by the service providers is reliable and transparent, the Authority is of the view that all the concerned service providers shall periodically provide this information to USOF Administrator and also post this data/information on their website. The format for providing this information is enclosed.

AND WHEREAS TRAI is concerned about the growth of telecom

services especially in rural and remote areas. Effective disbursement of

USOF shall accelerate pace of growth of telecom services in rural and

remote areas.

AND THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it

under Section 13 read with Section 11(1)(b) (ix) of the Telecom Regulatory

Authority of India Act 1997 the Authority directs all the UASPs and BSNL to

provide the information pertaining to USO related activities to USOF

administrator on monthly basis as per the enclosed format and post this

data/information on their company's website within 15 days of issue of this

Direction.
