## Comments on consultation paper on network testing before commercial launch of services.

The issue raised by the TRAI for stakeholders for their comments is a new one and may be offered their number of suggestions to be coming from the various stakeholders. The NCHSE feels that on this issue open house discussion should also be arranged. However, the comments of NCHSE question-wise are given below:

- 1. There should be restriction on the number of test SIM cards to be given to the users in the period of such use. The restriction of number of tests SIM cards should be limited to certain areas not to all circles of the departments. After testing these SIM cards which were issued for the purpose should automatically be inactive and fresh SIM cards should be provided by TSP to consumers.
- 2. Totally agree with the guidelines given in paras 1.12 and 1.13 to differentiate test phase from commercial launch of services by TSP. The limit of number of subscribers from 10000 plus can be considered looking to the spectrum allotted to TSP.
- 3. Fully agreed with the provisions discussed in Para 1.13.
- 4. There is a need to define time line for testing phase. But it will be very difficult to fix time line. In normal condition 3 months time should be sufficient for testing phase.
- 5. Since subscribers are enrolled as test users, therefore, no restriction or requirement should be imposed for the test subscribers.
- 6. MNP facility should not be allowed for test users / subscribers. If MNP is allowed in that case most of the users / subscribers may shift to another TSP and the TSP which has offered facility during testing period may suffer.
- 7. No other additional suggestion is offered by NCHSE.
