Sir,

Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI), New Delhi, is a statutory body set up under an Act of Parliament viz. the TRAI Act, 1997. TRAI has been established to regulate the Telecommunications Services and to protect the interest of service providers and consumers of the telecom sector, to promote and ensure orderly growth of the telecom sector and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto. The functions relating to regulation of Broadcasting and Cable Services Sectors have also been entrusted to TRAI from 2004.

2. The organization proposes to fill in **one post of Principal Private Secretary at TRAI HQ New Delhi on deputation on foreign service terms, initially for three years.** The required qualification and experience for the said post are given below: -

Officers of the Central Government or the State Governments or the Union Territory Administrations or Autonomous Body or Statutory Organisation or Public Sector Undertakings or recognised University or recognised Research Institution: - (i) holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or (ii) with six years of regular service rendered after appointment in the post of Private Secretary on regular basis in Level-7 (Rs.44900-142400) or equivalent in the parent cadre.

3. The appointment will be made on deputation on foreign service terms and will be governed by the instructions issued by the DoP&Trg. OM No. 6/8/2009-Estt. (Pay II) dated 17th June, 2010, as amended from time to time. **The maximum age for appointment on deputation shall in no case exceed 56 years on the last date of submission of applications in TRAI.**

4. The applicants fulfilling the eligibility criteria and having relevant experience, etc., may apply through **online mode only** on URL: <https://vacancies.trai.gov.in>.

All the Ministries/Departments, Central Public Sector Undertakings, Statutory and Autonomous Bodies of Government of India/State Governments are requested to forward duly attested hard copy of filled online application form (*downloaded from <https://vacancies.trai.gov.in>*) along with attested copies of ACRs/APARs for the last five years, vigilance/disciplinary clearance and cadre clearance of eligible candidates, whose services could be placed at the disposal of the Authority immediately in the event of their selection.
