My request: I should get For Rs. 19 or lesser Both SD and HD Streams. If I opt for SD, I should get HD free of charge, and vice versa.

If this concept is implemented by TRAI, it gives a lot relief to subscribers a lot, and eliminates confusion which stream or Packages to opt for.
