- Number of active wireless subscribers (on the date of peak VLR[#]) in September, 2023 was 1046.82 million.

I. Broadband Subscriber


As per the information received from 1,108 operators in September, 2023 in comparison to 1,087 Operator in August 2023, the total Broadband Subscribers increased from 876.53 million at the end of August-23 to 885 million at the end of September-23 with a monthly growth rate of 0.97%. Segment-wise broadband subscribers and their monthly growth rates are as below: -

• Top five service providers constituted 98.35% market share of the total broadband subscribers at the end of September-23. These service providers were Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd 458.96 million, Bharti Airtel 257.59 million, Vodafone Idea 126.51 million, BSNL 25.12 million and Atria Convergence 2.20 million.


• The graphical representation of the service provider-wise market share of broadband services is given below: -




- As on 30th September, 2023, the top five <u>Wired</u> Broadband Service providers were Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd 9.75 million, Bharti Airtel 7.03 million, BSNL 3.71 million, Atria Convergence Technologies 2.20 million and Hathway Cable & Datacom 1.12 million.
- As on 30th September, 2023, the top five <u>Wireless</u> Broadband Service providers were Reliance Jio Infocom Ltd 449.21 million, Bharti Airtel 250.57 million, Vodafone Idea 126.50 million, BSNL 21.41 million and Intech Online Pvt. Ltd. 0.24 million.

II. Wireline Subscribers

- Wireline subscribers increased from 30.78 million at the end of August-23 to 30.98 million at the end of September-23. Net increase in the wireline subscriber base was 0.20 million with a monthly growth rate of 0.66%. The share of urban and rural subscribers in total wireline subscribers were 91.35% and 8.65% respectively at the end of September, 2023.
- The Overall Wireline Tele-density in India increased from 2.21% at the end of August-23 to 2.22% at the end of September-23. Urban and Rural Wireline Tele-density were 5.74% and 0.30% respectively during the same period.
- BSNL, MTNL and APSFL, the three PSUs access service providers, held 29.52% of the wireline market share as on 30th September, 2023. Detailed statistics of wireline subscriber base are available at **Annexure-I**.




Access Service Provider-wise Market Share of Wireline Subscribers as on 30th September, 2023



III. Wireless subscriber

• Total wireless subscribers increased from 1,148.43 million at the end of August-23, to 1,150.15 million at the end of September-23, thereby registering a monthly growth rate of 0.15%. Wireless subscription in urban areas increased from 629.39 million at the end of August-23 to 630.17 million at the end of September-23 and wireless subscription in rural areas also increased from 519.04 million to 519.99 million during the same period. Monthly growth rate of urban and rural wireless subscription was 0.12% and 0.18% respectively.







The Wireless Tele-density in India increased from 82.48% at the end of August-23 to 82.54% at the end of September-23. The Urban Wireless Tele-density decreased from 127.84% at the end of August-23 to 127.81% at the end of September-23 however Rural Tele-density increased from 57.67% to 57.75% during the same period. The share of urban and rural wireless subscribers in total number of wireless subscribers was 54.79% and 45.21% respectively at the end of September-23. Detailed statistics of wireless subscriber base is available at **Annexure-II**.

• As on 30th September, 2023, the private access service providers held 91.69% market share of the wireless subscribers whereas BSNL and MTNL, the two PSU access service providers, had a market share of only 8.31%.


• The graphical representation of access service provider-wise market share and net additions in wireless subscriber base are given below: -

• Except, U.P.(E), Kerala, Punjab, U.P.(W), Haryana, Karnataka, Gujarat and Odisha, all other service areas have showed growth in their wireless subscribers during the month of September-23.

IV. Total Telephone Subscribers


The number of telephone subscribers in India increased from 1,179.21 million at the end of August-23 to 1,181.13 million at the end of September-23, thereby showing a monthly growth rate of 0.16%. Urban telephone subscription increased from 657.47 million at the end of August-23 to 658.46 million at the end of September-23 and the rural subscription also increased from 521.74 million to 522.66 million during the same period. The monthly growth rates of urban and rural telephone subscription were 0.15% and 0.18% respectively during the month of September-23.





• The overall Tele-density in India increased from 84.69% at the end of August-23 to 84.76% at the end of September-23. The Urban Tele-density decreased from 133.55% at the end of August-23 to 133.54% at the end of September-23 however Rural Tele-density increased from 57.97% to 58.05% during the same period. The share of urban and rural subscribers in total number of subscribers telephone at the end of September-23 was 55.75% and 44.25% respectively.

 As may be seen in the above chart, eight LSA have less tele-density than the all India average tele-density at the end of September-23. Delhi service area has maximum tele-density of 276.54% and the Bihar service area has minimum tele-density of 55.98% at the end of September-23.



- As can be seen in the above tables, in wireless segment, on monthly basis all circles have registered growth rate in their subscriber base. On yearly basis, except Circle 'B', all other circles have registered growth rate in their subscriber base.
- In Wireline segment, on monthly and yearly basis, all circles have registered growth rate in their subscriber base.


VI. Active Wireless Subscribers (VLR Data)

- Out of the total 1,150.15 million wireless subscribers, 1046.82 million wireless subscribers were active on the date of peak VLR in the month of September-23. The of active wireless proportion subscribers approximately was 91.02% of the total wireless subscriber base.
- The detailed statistics on proportion active of wireless subscribers (also referred to as VLR subscribers) on the date of peak VLR in the month of September-23 is available at Annexure-III and the methodology used for reporting VLR subscribers is available at **Annexure-IV**.

 Bharti Airtel has the maximum proportion 99.57% of its active wireless subscribers (VLR) as against its total wireless subscribers (HLR) on the date of peak VLR in the month of September-23 and MTNL has the minimum proportion of VLR 32.31% of its HLR during the same period.



VII. Mobile Number Portability (MNP)

- Intra-service area Mobile number portability (MNP) was implemented first in Haryana service area w.e.f. 25.11.2010 and in the rest of the country w.e.f. 20.01.2011. Inter-Service Area MNP has been implemented in the country w.e.f. 03.07.2015. Now, the wireless telephone subscribers can retain their mobile numbers when they relocate from one service area to another.
- During the month of September-23, a total of 12.65 million requests were received for MNP. Out of total 12.65 million new requests, 7.21 million requests received from Zone-I and 5.44 million requests received from Zone-II. The cumulative MNP requests increased from 877.43 million at the end of August-23 to 890.08 million at the end of September-23, since the implementation of MNP.
- In MNP Zone-I (Northern and Western India), the highest number of requests till date have been received in Uttar Pradesh-East (about 80.29 million) followed by Maharashtra (about 73.30 million) service area.

• In MNP Zone-II (Southern and Eastern India), the highest number of requests till date have been received in Madhya Pradesh (about 68.21 million) followed by Karnataka (about 63.41 million).

VLR Subscribers in the Wireless Segment

Home Location Register (HLR) is a central database that contains details of each mobile phone subscriber that is authorized to use the GSM core network. The HLRs store details of every SIM card issued by the service provider. Each SIM has a unique identifier called an International Mobile Subscriber Identity (IMSI), which is the primary key to each HLR record. The HLR data is stored for as long as a subscriber remains with the service provider. HLR also manages the mobility of subscribers by means of updating their position in administrative areas. It sends the subscriber data to a Visitor Location Register (VLR).

Subscriber numbers reported by the service providers is the difference between the numbers of IMSI registered in service provider's HLR and sum of other figures as given below: -

Visitor Location Register (VLR) is a temporary database of the subscribers who have roamed into the particular area, which it serves. Each base station in the network is served by exactly one VLR; hence a subscriber cannot be present in more than one VLR at a time.

If subscriber is in active stage i.e. he is able to send/receive calls/SMSs he is available both in HLR and VLR. However, it may be possible that the subscriber is registered in HLR but not in VLR due to the reason that he is either switched-off or moved out of coverage area, not reachable etc. In such circumstances he will be available in HLR but not in VLR. This causes difference between subscriber number reported by the service providers based on HLR and numbers available in VLR.

The VLR subscriber data calculated here is based on active subscribers in VLR on the date of Peak subscriber number in VLR of the particular month for which the data is being collected. This data is to be taken from the switches having the purge time of not more than 72 hours.
