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- Telecom Subscribers maintain growth during January 2006. Total 5 million additions, more than 4.7 million additions in mobile alone.
- Gross around 130 million, Teledensity nears 12%
- Broadband base touches first Million, Internet Subscribers base crosses 7.5 million.
- 2 Free to Air Channels (FTA) converted to Pay Channels in January, 2006.
- Domestic Leased Line Tariff lower by 25% to 48% from TRAI's ceiling tariff.
- International Private Leased Circuit (IPLC) tariff lower by 2% to 7% from TRAI's Ceiling tariff.

1. Subscribers Base: -

As per a compilation done by TRAI based on latest reports from operators, the subscriber base for telephony services has shown a record growth of 4.97 million subscribers during January,2006, as compared to 4.92 million subscribers in December, 2005. During the first 10 months of year 2005-2006 around 31.41 million subscribers have been added.

For mobile segment 4.69 million subscribers have been added during January,2006 as compared to 4.46 million in December, 2005. The mobile additions consist of 3.52 million GSM subscribers and 1.17 million CDMA subscribers as against 3.19 million GSM and 1.27 million CDMA last month.

During the first ten months of current financial year about 28.39 million mobile subscribers were added, making it a total of 80.61 million mobile subscribers at the end of January,2006.

The comparison of month-wise addition in mobile subscriber base for 2003-04, 2004-05 & 2005-06 is as follows:

In the fixed segment, a total of 0.28 million subscribers were added during January,2006, which were predominantly WLL (F). With this the total subscriber base of fixed lines have reached 49.21 million.

The gross subscribers' base consisting of fixed as well as mobile has reached around 130 million.

2. Teledensity: -

The tele-density at the end of January,2006 has reached near 12 % as compared to 11.43 at the end of previous month.

3. Internet Services & Broadband Growth: -

Total Broadband connections (>256 Kbps download) in the country have touched around 10 lakhs only as against a target of 30 lakhs for December,2005 in Broadband Policy-2004. Internet Subscriber target of 60 lakhs for December,2005 was exceeded in December,2005 itself thus showing that there is a demand for both broadband and internet but the service providers are not being able to fulfil the broadband demand.

4. Domestic Leased Circuits (DLC) & International Private Leased

Circuits (IPLC) tariff:- Various operators have offered different discount below the TRAI's Ceiling Tariff based on the duration capacities & routes. It ranges from 25% to 48% for DLC. All the 3 major ILDOs have filed their tariff complying with the IPLC Ceiling tariff of TRAI effective from 29th November,2005. Some discounts in the range of 2% to 7% are also available in the market based on various capacities & routes.
