The implementation of the Telecommunication Mobile Number Portability (Ninth Amendment) Regulations, 2024 w.e.f. 00:00:00 hours of 01.07.2024

New Delhi, 28th June 2024 — The Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI), on 14th March, 2024, issued the Telecommunication Mobile Number Portability (Ninth amendment) Regulations, 2024, which will come into force on 1st July, 2024.

- 2. These amendment regulations are aimed at curbing the porting of mobile numbers by way of fraudulent SIM swap/ replacement by unscrupulous elements. Through these amendment regulations, an additional criterion for the rejection of the request for allocation of a Unique Porting Code (UPC) has been introduced. Specifically, a UPC shall not be allocated if the request for the UPC has been made before the expiry of seven days from the date of SIM swap/ replacement.
