
Telecom Regulatory Authority of India

On 6th July 2024, the Mobile Number Portability (MNP) requests processed in the country since January 2011 crossed the 100 crore (1 Billion) mark.

New Delhi, 26th July 2024 — Mobile Number Portability (MNP) was introduced in India on 20th January 2011, in accordance with Telecommunication Mobile Number Portability Regulations, 2009 issued by the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI). The MNP allows a telecom subscriber to retain his mobile number when switching from one service provider to another, anywhere in the country. At present, about 11 million porting requests are processed in a month in India.

2. On 6th July 2024, the porting requests processed in the country since January 2011 in India crossed the 100 crore (1 Billion) mark.
